Diving for Dollars: Donations Needed

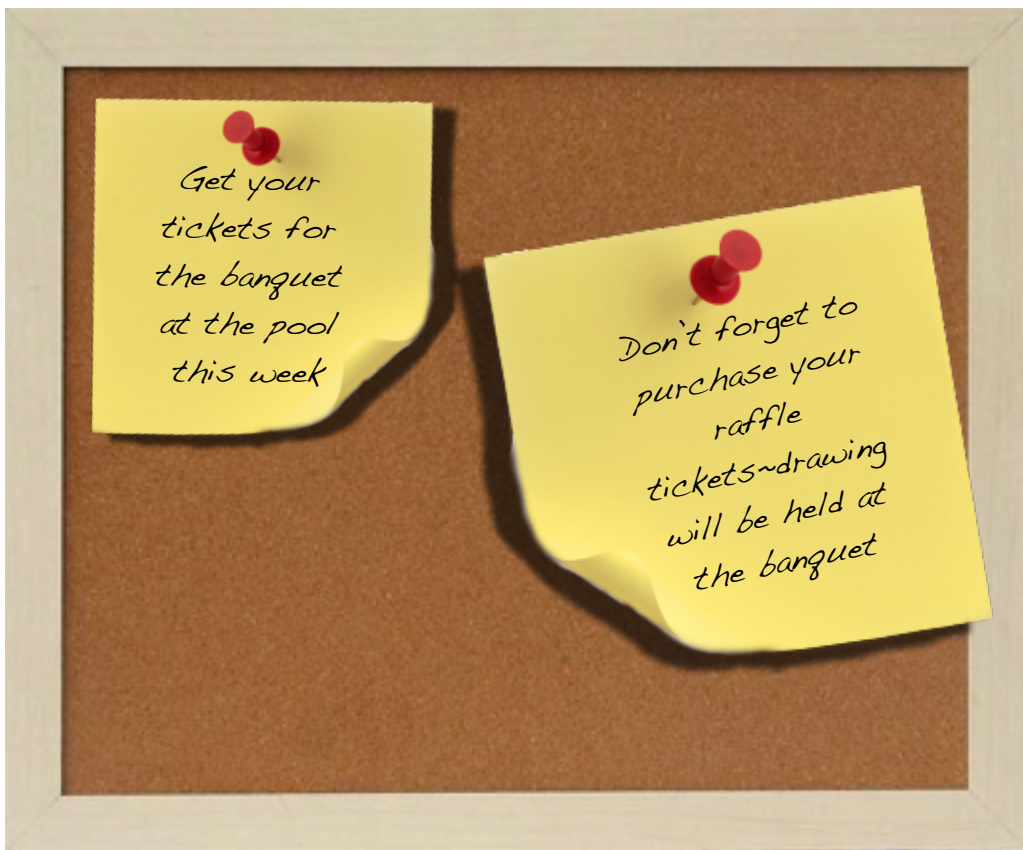

- Merchandise will be for sale under the Barracuda tent.

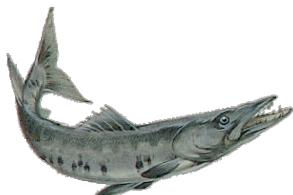

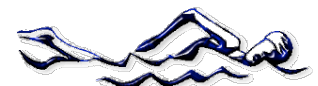
Last Chance and Champ Meet Sign-Ups
