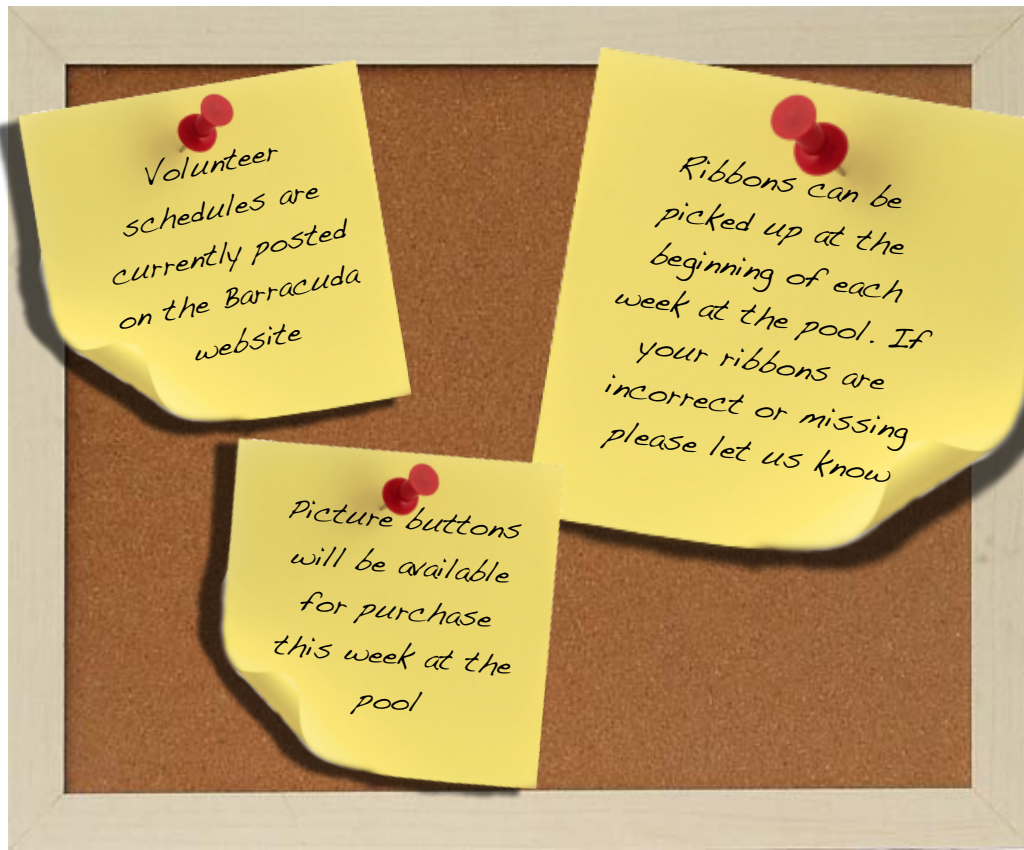
## Volunteer Spot

## Stroke Clinics

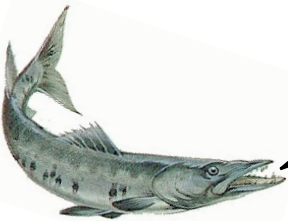
There is still some space for **STROKE CLINIC 2** next week, June 13-16
