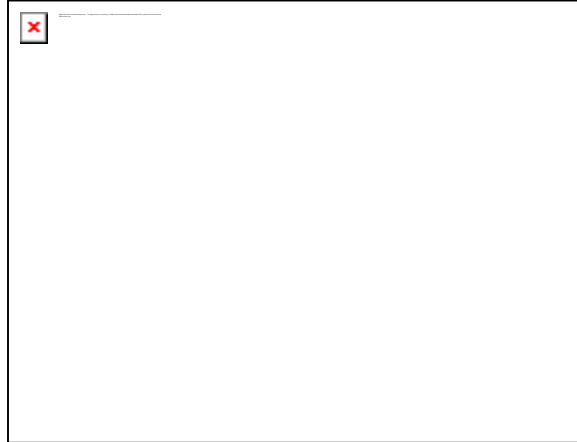

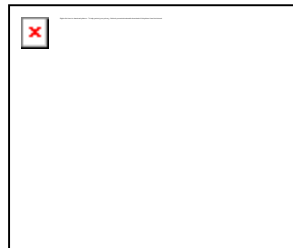

Food/Concessions

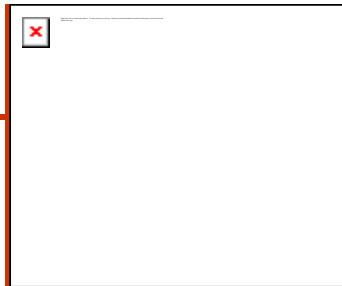

Stroke Clinic

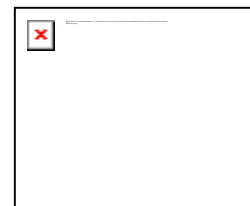
We will begin signups for the stroke clinics beginning next Tuesday 6/1 during practices. The stroke clinic is an additional session that allows your swimmer more one-on-one instruction from some of the coaches. The ratio is typically 1 coach to 5 swimmers. The

time is from 10:30 AM - 11:30 AM beginning June 7th. They are four days long (M-TH) and we will hold three with the last one starting June 21st. Slots are limited, so please be sure to sign up. The cost is \$45.00.
