## Notes to Coaches

With the upcoming meets approaching, the coaches need to know if a Barracuda is not going to swim



at the meet! There is a red Barracuda Box hanging on the wall to drop in note to the coaches to let them know the **DATE** that the swimmer will not attend. This needs to be in the box by the **TUESDAY** before the meet.



Parents, please be prompt picking up your child as soon as his/her practice is over. We do not have the personnel to supervise your children.

## FYI

It is important to show up for all swim events that a Barracuda is signed up to swim. This is particularly true in the case of relays. A Barracuda that leaves early or does not show up for a relay results in the relay being disqualified. This is very discouraging for the other members of the relay who have stayed to swim this event. Therefore, if this happens, the swimmer that causes the disqualification will **NOT** be entered in a relay the next swim meet.



### Please Stand Back!

All parents need to stay back 20 feet from the pool's edge as this allows our coaches to properly coach our swimmers.
