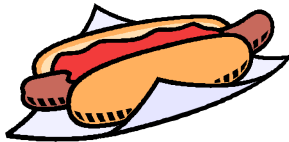

For those of you that are new, we have **set-up** on Friday night at 7:30.

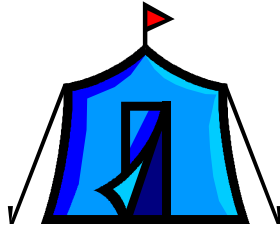

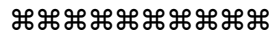


Tear down is just as important as set up! Please consider helping out after the meet to pick up trash and tear down of the tents.
